

- Do not connect your device (workstation, cellphone or iPad) to BellMTS Guest Wifi while at the hospital (other than at these locations: CCMB MacCharles or 700 Elgin); it will break your connection to MS Teams, Connection Dialer (Virtual Visit Provider Portal) and MyMBT Messaging (Cortext).
- Due to the potential security and privacy risks associated with the TikTok app, you must delete the app from your work or personal device prior to installing and using MyMBT Messaging (Cortext) on that device.
- 1. Click here from your mobile device to install the app. Configure your connection and notification settings as shown on pg 2.
- Log in with your **<user name>@mymbt.ca** and your network password. (Each time you change your network password you will be prompted to update it in MyMBT Messaging.)


Connection & Notification Settings

Proper settings ensure that alerts for new and unread messages are displayed when the application is not running. Follow the steps below (images are based on a Samsung, so they may look different on your device).

Ensure notifications for new messages will display on the lock screen:


Settings>Apps>Cortext>Notifications

Set all 3 options: Routine, Silent & Urgent Alerts.




Ensure cellular connection settings are appropriate:

Settings>Apps>Cortext>Mobile data



Ensure phone Wi-Fi avoids poor connections:


Settings>Connections>Wi-Fi> > Advanced > Switch to Mobile Data



Turn off power saving mode:

Settings>Device Maintenance>Battery>Unmonitored apps

Add cortext app to ensure you will get alerts even when battery is running low.



Ensure alert settings are enabled:

Open Cortext>Settings>Urgent Alerts/Routine Alerts

Also select user preferences for these 3 options.



Turn this option **on** if you need to receive alerts even when you have turned your phone to silent mode.
