


Start by tapping your profile circle in the top left of your screen and then tap **Notifications.**






Recommended channel notifications for clinical secure messaging

For clinical secure messaging, it is recommended you set your notifications at the channel level as shown below.

This will <u>limit the notifications you receive to one-on-one chats and group chats</u> which are associated with clinical secure messaging since they can contain PHI.





Team - group of people, conversations, files and tools **Channel -** teams are made up of channels, this is where the work gets done

One-on-one chat - chat with one other person
Group chat - with a few people at once, but <u>outside</u> a channel
Channel chat - with everyone on the team who follows the
channel (never use for PHI)

Changing channel notifications

You'll always get notifications to <u>your</u> replies whether a channel is on or off.

By default, channel notifications are <u>off</u>. You can adjust them at any time based on current relevance, priority and workflow. For instance:

- you may be a member of twenty Teams, but you only want notifications on your mobile device for channels within two of the Teams
- maybe there is a channel that is used for posting urgent information that needs to be acted on, or you're working on a project. In these instances, you probably want to ensure you get the notifications on your phone
